Bicycles on PATCO

The following bicycle rules are in effect during the continuous 24/7 Ben Franklin Bridge track outages:

PATCO customers may transport folded bicycles on PATCO rail cars at any time.

During the Bridge Track Rehabilitation Project, cyclists may transport regular bicycles on PATCO trains at any time EXCEPT:

6:45 to 9 a.m. Monday-Friday if traveling westbound (toward Philadelphia)

3:45 to 6:15 p.m. Monday-Friday if traveling eastbound (toward Lindenwold)

When PATCO is not running a Track Construction schedule, bicycles are permitted on PATCO trains at any time.

Cyclists must yield to all other passengers at all times.

Under no circumstances may escalators be used.

On-board trains, cyclist must hold the bicycle firmly, with kickstand up, between windscreens of the non-platform side doorway.

Cyclists are liable for any damage to property or injury to persons.

Cyclists must not sit on or ride bikes while in or on any stations, platforms or trains.
