Reconstruction of Ivywood Avenue
Storm Drainage Construction on Memorial Avenue

Dear Resident:

The Township of Haddon has received bids to reconstruct Ivywood Avenue from Patton Avenue to the dead end at the high school tennis courts. The project will also include constructing a new storm pipe on Memorial Avenue, in front of the high school.

The contractor for the project is Midwest Construction from Cherry Hill, NJ.

The construction work will take place in two separate parts. During the week of August 9, 2010, the contractor will begin constructing storm drainage piping on Memorial Avenue, in front of the high school. This portion of the project must be completed before September 3, 2010 or the start of the new school year. PSE&G Gas Division will also be performing maintenance work to the existing gas mains at the intersection of Ivywood Avenue and Pyle Avenue during this time frame.

We do not expect the contractor to begin working on the reconstruction of Ivywood Avenue until late September. This part of the project will include constructing new concrete curbing and driveway aprons on Ivywood Avenue. PVC piping will also be installed for residents to connect their sump pump discharge piping so ice does not form in the street during the winter months. New bituminous paving will also be constructed.

During the period of construction, residents and motorists may experience some inconveniences. However, the contractor will make every possible effort to minimize said inconveniences. Emergency vehicles such as fire apparatus, ambulance and police vehicles will have access to the roadway at all times. Local traffic will be maintained for a majority of the time. However, during the period of time that the contractor is working in the vicinity of your property, you may experience some inconvenience.

This project, which is funded by the Township, will be inspected by Key Engineers, Inc.

Your patience and cooperation during the tie of construction is requested and sincerely appreciated. We are confident that the completed project will more than compensate for the inconveniences you may experience during the period of construction.
