ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HADDON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 111 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HADDON ENTITLED "FEES"

WHEREAS, the Township of Haddon ("Township"), is a municipal entity organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 111 of the Code of the Township sets forth the various fees, deposits and payments required to be made for licenses and permits issued by the Township; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-1, the Governing Body is authorized to enact and amend ordinances as deemed necessary to manage, regulate and control the finances of the Township and to fix the fees for services rendered by any officer or employee of the Township;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Commissioners of the Township of Haddon, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 111-19 of the Code of the Township of Haddon is hereby amended, revised and supplemented in the following manner:

§ 111-19. Fees for peddling and soliciting from Chapter 177

- A. In accordance with §177-4(D), a fee of \$75.00 shall be paid upon the filing of the application for a permit to peddle or solicit in the Township.
- B. In accordance with §177-36, a fee of \$500.00 shall be paid upon the filing of the application for a permit to hawk, peddle or canvass in the Township.

SECTION 2: Except as set forth in Section 1, the balance of Chapter 111 shall not be affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4: If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance.
