

Property Tax Relief Programs Township of Haddon

Veteran's Deduction: \$250/year

- Must have served during wartime (see application for more details).
- Must be a current resident of NJ.
- Must have owned property as of October 1 of the preceding year.

Widow of a Veteran: \$250/year

- Deceased must meet the requirements for Veteran's Deduction.
- Veteran needed to be a NJ resident at the time of death.
- Widow cannot be remarried.

Senior Citizen or Disabled: \$250/year (can only claim one)

- Must be either 65 years old or disabled.
- Household income must be under \$10,000 not including Social Security and excluding restrictions.
- Must be a resident of the property.
- Must fill out required paperwork each year.

Surviving Spouse: \$250/year

- Applicable for the spouse of deceased senior citizen or disabled individual who has not remarried.
- Applicant must be between the ages of 55-64.
- Must fill out income statement each year.

Tax Exemption

- 100% tax exemption for a disabled veteran or the widow of a disabled or deceased individual due to wartime service.
- Need proof from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

Property Tax Reimbursement Program (Tax Freeze Program)

- Must qualify for 2 years before applying.
- Need to be at least 65 years old or disabled.
- Must have been a NJ resident for 10 years.
- Must have owned and resided in said property for 3 years.
- Total marital income needs to have been under \$70,000 for 2008 and \$80,000 for 2009.

Homestead Rebate
