*Tony Black, Haddon Township-* Mr. Black stated that he had lived in Haddon Township since 1959 and had concern with the state of the Maple Avenue Westmont Bridge. Mr. Black stated that he had walked the route as a child and his children have also used the route as a walking path. Mr. Black reported that since the renovations, cars have jumped the bridge curbing, with only 3 ½ -4 inch cement curb separating the pedestrians from the roadway. Mr. Black noted that the increase in accidents may be attributable to more inattentive drivers with the abundance of social media and cell phones. Mr. Black suggested that consideration be given to the installation of a steel guard rail or panel to protect the pedestrians traffic from the vehicular traffic. Mr. Black cautioned that the Township should investigate the danger before any serious problems were to occur. Mayor Teague stated that the Township would have the engineer visit the site and make recommendations on possible implementation of a safety mechanism.

Recognizing no other public attendees who wished to speak, Commissionr Mulroy motioned to close the floor to the public, seconded by Mayor Teague and hearing none opposed, motion was carried.




