This can be done between **Wednesday, January 22, 2020 and Friday, February 14, 2020, between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:00 pm.** Once the applications have been reviewed, notifications will be made to the applicant regarding the first phase of the hiring process.

The deadline for submitting applications will be **Friday, February 14, 2020, at 4:00 pm.** A formal resume shall also be submitted along with your completed application. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- **Be a citizen of the United States.**
- **Be of good moral character and free from conviction of any crime constituting an indictable offense or any crime or offense involving moral turpitude.**
- **Must have satisfactorily completed police academy training with certification from the New Jersey Police Training Commission (Basic Course for Police Officer) or SLEO II certification currently within a waiver period or currently enrolled in a New Jersey Police Academy.**
- **Have sufficient good mental and bodily health to satisfy the Board of Trustees of the Police and Fireman's Retirement System of New Jersey that he/she is eligible for membership in the retirement system.**
- **The ability to competently read, write, and speak the English language.**
- **Pass any written, oral, physical and psychological examinations.**
- **Have the ability to perform all essential functions of a police officer.**
- **Graduated from an accredited high school or possess a graduate equivalency degree (GED).**
- **Possess a valid New Jersey driver's license.**
- **Meet all other requirements contained in N.J.S.A. 40A:14-127.**
