Mayor Teague reported that he would like to give a brief summary of Resolution #2022-093 involving the building at Westmont Plaza that was the old Wells Fargo Bank and prior to that the old People's Bank. Mayor Teague stated the owner of the building has owned it for quite some time. Mayor Teague said the building was occupied by Wells Fargo and he believes they have moved the employees out of the building and since, there have been some issues with people going into the empty building. Mayor Teague reported the owner has been looking for different things to do with the building, originally, he had it up for sale and then he decided to look at something to do with the property. He came to us with an idea of housing and office space there. Mayor Teague stated that the Township is going to explore that idea which is the purpose of the Memorandum of Understanding. There is nothing definitive other than a general concept which the owner has provided as part of the package tonight. The owner has also provided Township with a \$15,000

escrow fee for the Township professionals to begin the work to see if the owner can take this project to fruition, reported Mayor Teague.

Commissioner Linhart asks Mayor Teague to comment on Resolution #2022-090 – RFP for Municipal Pocket Park Landscape Engineer. Mayor Teague reported that the Township received a grant from County Open Space for the property next to the Municipal Building. The Mayor stated that we have been making an effort to improve the Township properties and buildings. Mayor Teague further report that the Township improved Champion School last year, as well as the pollinator garden. Mayor Teague commented that the Township is going to be improving the railway station over in the West Collingswood Extension. The Township also applied for another \$25,000 for the area next to the Municipal Building as well and Commissioner Linhart has been organizing a group of volunteers and they have been coming up with some different ideas. They had an open public forum outside for various ideas for the area and let the residents have some input and they voted on many ideas. The volunteers sorted the ideas out and they whittled them down to something nice and the idea is that they can use those county funds to hire a Landscape Architect to fine tune the concept idea that was envisioned by Commissioner Linhart and the volunteers.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SALARIES TO BE PAID TO THE EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HADDON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, DESIGNATING THE VARIOUS POSITIONS, AMOUNTS OF SALARY AND TIME OF PAYMENT

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Haddon, County of Camden and State of New Jersey, Section 1. of Ordinance #1425 adopted on June 28, 2022 is hereby amended to include:

SECTION 1. The following salaries shall be paid at the time designated to the employees of the Township of Haddon, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, who hold or are appointed to the positions enumerated below, beginning September 1, 2022, date of appointment or as specifically noted.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HADDON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE TOWNSHIP OF HADDON PLANNING BOARD TO UNDERTAKE A PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE PROPOSED STUDY AREA WHICH INCLUDES BLOCK 13.03, LOT 3 IS TO BE DELINEATED AS AN AREA IN NEED OF NON-CONDEMNATION REDEVELOPMENT PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL REDEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING LAW (N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 ET SEQ)

WHEREAS, the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et seq. (“LRHL”) provides a mechanism to assist local governments in efforts to promote programs of redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, the LRHL sets forth the procedures for the Township to declare an area in need of redevelopment, along with the development and effectuation of a redevelopment plan; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the required redevelopment procedures, specifically set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6, no area of a municipality shall be determined a redevelopment area unless the governing body of the municipality shall, by Resolution, authorize the Planning Board to undertake a preliminary investigation to determine whether a proposed area is a redevelopment area meeting the criteria set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Legislature adopted, and the Governor signed, P.L. 2013, Chapter 159, which amended the LRHL, including the procedural requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5 and N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to P.L. 2013, Chapter 159, “[t]he resolution authorizing the planning board to undertake a preliminary investigation shall state whether the redevelopment area determination shall authorize the municipality to use all those powers provided by the Legislature for use in a redevelopment area other than the use of eminent domain (“Non-Condensation Redevelopment Area”) or whether the redevelopment area determination shall authorize the municipality to use all those powers provided by the Legislature for use in a redevelopment area, including the power of eminent domain (“Condensation Redevelopment Area”); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Haddon seek to authorize and recommend the Township of Haddon Planning Board to conduct a preliminary investigation of the Study Area as an area in need of redevelopment to be a Non-Condensation Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, the Area in question is located at or along West Cuthbert Blvd. and the area is located at Block 13.03, Lot 3 identified as the Study Area, may benefit from the tools available to municipalities under the LRHL and efforts to encourage private development with existing

owners for increased employment and housing opportunities, tax rates and other benefits which communities generally derive from the redevelopment of lands in these areas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds it to be in the best interest of the Township and its residents to authorize the Township Planning Board to undertake such preliminary investigation of the Study Area as a Non-Condensation Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Haddon wishes to direct the Township of Haddon Planning Board to undertake a preliminary investigation utilizing Key Engineers to prepare the preliminary investigation, to determine whether the proposed Study Area, which includes Block 13.03, Lot 3 qualify as an area in need of Non-Condensation Redevelopment pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5; and

WHEREAS, 600 Cuthbert, LLC and the Township of Haddon entered into a Memorandum of Understanding whereby 600 Cuthbert, LLC shall be responsible to pay for all expenses incurred by the Township of Haddon and Planning Board in conjunction with the request; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Haddon are empowered to authorize this preliminary investigation to be conducted by the Township of Haddon Planning Board pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6 as a Non-Condensation Redevelopment Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Haddon, County of Camden and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The provisions of the WHEREAS clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

The Township of Haddon Planning Board is hereby authorized to undertake a preliminary investigation, utilizing Key Engineers to prepare the preliminary investigation, pursuant to a notice to conduct a hearing and comply with other requirements of the LRHL, in order to recommend to the Board of Commissioners whether the area comprising the Study Area is an area in need of Non-Condensation Redevelopment according to the criteria set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5.
3. Pursuant to New Jersey P.L.2013, Chapter 159, the redevelopment area determination shall authorize the Township to use all those powers provided by the Legislature for use in a Non-Condensation Redevelopment Area, other than the use of eminent domain.
4. The Township of Haddon Planning Board shall provide a written Report to the Board of Commissioners setting forth its findings resulting from such preliminary investigation and shall recommend to the Board of Commissioners whether said properties are an "Area in Need of Redevelopment" under the meaning and intent of the LRHL.
5. The Township of Haddon Planning Board shall submit its findings and recommendations to the Board of Commissioners in the form of a Resolution with supporting documents.
