**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HADDON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, AND  
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND REVISING CHAPTER 223 OF THE  
CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HADDON ENTITLED "TRAFFIC REGULATIONS"**

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**WHEREAS**, Chapter 223 of the Code of the Township of Haddon (the "Code"), entitled "Traffic Regulations," sets forth traffic regulations within the Township, including multi-way stop intersections; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Engineer has investigated the intersection at Ivywood Avenue and Pyle Avenue and has recommended to the Governing Body that a four-way stop is appropriate for the intersection in question and that appropriate "stop" signage be installed; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-8, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197 and N.J.S.A. 39:4-140, the Township Committee has the authority to regulate the passage or stopping of traffic at certain intersections, including the establishment of multi-way stop controls; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2, the Governing Body is authorized to enact and amend ordinances as deemed necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and as may be necessary to carry into effect the powers and duties conferred and imposed upon the Township by law.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Township of Haddon, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Chapter 223, Section 29 of the Code of the Township of Haddon, entitled "Multi-way stop intersections," is hereby amended and revised solely as to Ivywood Avenue and Memorial Avenue/Pyle Avenue as follows:

**§ 229-29 Multi-way stop intersections.**

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-140, the following intersections are designated as multi-way stop intersections. Stop signs shall be installed as provided herein.

<b>Intersection</b>	<b>Type</b>
Ivywood Avenue and Memorial Avenue/Pyle Avenue	4-way

**SECTION 2:** Except as set forth in Section 1 above, the balance of the Code of the Township of Haddon shall not be affected by this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3:** All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

**SECTION 4:** If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.

**The foregoing Ordinance was introduced by the Mayor and Commissioners at the regular meeting held on January 24, 2023. This Ordinance will be considered for adoption on final reading and public hearing to be held on February 28, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. in the Meeting Room, Haddon Township Municipal Building, 135 Haddon Avenue, Westmont, New Jersey.**
