ORDINANCE NO. 1447

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HADDON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND REVISING CHAPTER 54 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HADDON ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT"

WHEREAS, Chapter 54 of the Code of the Township of Haddon (the "Code"), entitled

"Police Department," regulates the operation of the Haddon Township Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Article VII of Chapter 54 regulates extra-duty assignments of Township Police Department personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to revise Article VII to allow the third-party administration of extra-duty assignments within the Township; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2, the Board of Commissioners is authorized to enact and amend ordinances as deemed necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and as may be necessary to carry into effect the powers and duties conferred and imposed upon the Township by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Township of Haddon, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 54, Section 32 of the Code of the Township of Haddon, entitled "Responsibility for compensation; special escrow account," is hereby amended, revised, and supplemented as follows:

§ 54-32 Responsibility for compensation; special escrow account.

Hourly rates for extra-duty assignments shall be as follows:

- E. Notwithstanding the above, the Township holds the right to seek a third-party company for the police departments Off-Duty Employment services for Off-Duty Program Administration. The chosen service provider may charge an additional fee other than the officer, administration or any other fees set forth in this Article. This service may handle scheduling, billing, collections, pay or any other services previously performed by the Township.

SECTION 2: Except as set forth in Section 1 above, the balance of the Code of the Township of Haddon shall not be affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

SECTION 4: If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
