

The 16th Annual Turkey Tronsk and 1 Mile Fun Run/Walk Saturday, November 25

The 16th Annual Turkey Trot 5K and 1 Mile Fun Run/Walk returns to Haddon Township on Saturday, November 25! The race begins at the Haddon Township Municipal Building (135 Haddon Avenue) and ends at The Pour House (124 Haddon Avenue) with a breakfast reception and awards ceremony after the race.

The 1-mile Fun Run/Walk begins at 8:45 a.m. and the 5K race will begin at 9 a.m. Long sleeve t-shirts will be provided for to the first 700 registrants and for the top winners for overall male and female categories in various divisions. There will also be prizes awarded to the top three runners who complete the race or Fun Run/Walk in a Turkey themed costume.




Save the Date! Winterfest 7 Saturday, December 2
