The wait is over! The doors are officially open and we couldn't be more excited to welcome Uncommon Pantry to 162 Haddon Ave.



10 a.m. – 1 p.m.


The Go Green Drive Thru will take place on West Park Boulevard and Crystal Lake Avenue on Saturday, April 11 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. This event will feature document **Shredding, Disposal of Electronic Waste and Medical as well as the Disposal of Pharmaceutical products.** Haddon Township Police will be on site during this event to monitoring document shredding. Residents are advised to **not bring paint or other hazardous materials.**

All materials intended for disposal should be placed in the rear cargo area, trunk, or pick-up bed of the vehicle. Haddon Township Department of Public Works personnel will handle and unload materials for disposal. All residents should remain in their cars during this process. The Go Green Drive Thru is a rain or shine event.
