

ORDINANCE #1467

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HADDON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, AND
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND REVISING CHAPTER 223, ARTICLE II
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HADDON ENTITLED “STOPPING,
STANDING AND PARKING”**

WHEREAS, Chapter 223, Article II of the Code of the Township of Haddon (the “Township”), entitled “Stopping, Standing and Parking,” sets forth rules and regulations concerning the parking of vehicles in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that the repairing of vehicles upon public roadways creates a safety hazard for the residents of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Commissioners therefore seeks to amend Chapter 223, Article II to prohibit same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2, the Board of Commissioners is authorized to enact and amend ordinances as deemed necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and as may be necessary to carry into effect the powers and duties conferred and imposed upon the Township by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Township of Haddon, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 223, Article II of the Code of the Township of Haddon, entitled “Stopping, Standing and Parking,” is hereby amended, revised, and supplemented to establish Section 18.1, “Repairs prohibited,” as follows:

§ 223-18.1 Repairs prohibited.

No motor vehicle of any type whatsoever shall be repaired on any public streets or public highways located within the Township except for emergency repair, which emergency repair work shall be limited solely to that required in order to remove any such vehicle from the public street or public highway.

SECTION 2: Except as set forth in Section 1 above, the balance of the Code of the Township of Haddon shall not be affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

SECTION 4: If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of

judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
